

The Bassetts of Limpsfield

This family descends from William Bassett who was born in 1755 in Limpsfield, Surrey and who is thought to have been a son of Michael Bassett born about 1725 in Pains Hill, Surrey. Pains Hill is a hamlet within Limpsfield. It is likely that Michael was related to the ancestors of the Bassetts of Chiddingstone as they too were in the Limpsfield area and the incidence of twins is common to both families. It also occurs in the Bassetts of Lewes whose ancestry may also be linked to the Chiddingstone Bassetts.
